- Coordination of travel and data collection schedule with Regional Coordinator
- Travel to identified food pantries within assigned region
- Recruit survey participants
- Support food pantry clients in completing surveys
- Conduct follow-up phone interviews with food pantry clients
- Enter surveys into online data platform
- Potential for overnight stays dependent on travel requirements (lodging and per diem provided for extended trips)
